#### 1. A Soldier's Surrender \_\_\_\_\_

*For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it. Mark 8:35*

I Surrender Story Scriptures:

- *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23 NIV*
