## **Ephesians for Everyman:** *Identity Crisis*

Week Three: Ephesians 3

Oftentimes, we wrongly see the sharing of our faith as a duty to perform. As a task to check off our list. We view evangelism as something we have to do, rather than something we get to enter into with God. Take a look at Paul's encouragements:

"...you know that God gave me the special responsibility of extending His grace to you Gentiles...." - Ephesians 3:2

"By God's grace and mighty power, I have been given the privilege of serving Him by spreading the Good News...." - Ephesians 3:7

"He (God) graciously gave me the privilege of telling the Gentiles about the endless treasures available to them in Christ." - Ephesians 3:8

For God's man, we must recognize the simple and profound beauty that sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ \_\_\_\_\_\_\_.

"And so, my judgment is that we should **not make it difficult** for the Gentiles who are turning to God." - Acts 15:19
