The list of "spiritual weeds" in this passage reminds us that:

- Weeds often pop up after a good "rain". Challenges often follow successes.
- Weeds must be removed at the source. Do the hard work, dig deep or they will just come back.
- The hardest weeds to remove, are the ones closest to the core of the bush. Like lies about the core of our identity, these are the hardest to remove.
- It's hard to remove weeds, that look like flowers. Deception that looks like truth is the hardest to recognize.
