- Confronting long held beliefs, and being willing to stand alone
- Ensuring he sees Jesus Christ clearly
- Submitting to the transformative power of the Word of God
- Remembering that one changed man...is not who he used to be! AMEN!

As we look at the life of the Demonic, we can see a few patterns of evil that help us in our battle against the enemy. **First, evil** _____.

Beware of the enemy's schemes to get you *alone*:

"Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour." - 1 Peter 5:8

"When Jesus was still some distance away, the man saw him, ran to meet him, and bowed low before him. With a shriek, he screamed, "Why are you interfering with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? In the name of God, I beg you, don't torture me!" For Jesus had already said to the spirit, "Come out of the man, you evil spirit." - Mark 5:6

No matter our aim and effort, like the man amongst the tombs - the best first step for both our obedience and our healing is **always** _____.

In a moment, and with a word, Jesus undoes everything the enemy had done:

- From Isolation to community and purpose
- From living out of a false identity, to the truth of his sonship
- He was no longer who he had *been*.....HE WAS FREE!

***A changed man, is** _____ **!!!**

Set free from what? From sin, from separation, from fear and doubt....and the control of the enemy. *"If you refuse to do what is right, then watch out! Sin is crouching at the door, eager to control you. But you must subdue it and be its master."* - Genesis 4:7

You must ask yourself.... **"What is controlling me?"**

"As Jesus was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon possessed begged to go with him." - Mark 5:18

The man was free. Made new. He recognized Christ was the one who had changed him and so, he wanted to go with Him....but Christ says no. Instead..Jesus says, *"Go home."*

How could this be? Shouldn't the man have gone? This surprising response by Jesus reminds us of an important truth: **As we follow Jesus: To us is** _____, **and to Jesus are the** _____ **and the** _____.

So often we want to GO...but Christ can call us to *stay*. In response to the leading of the Holy Spirit...One changed man begins building the Kingdom _____.

Sometimes we board a plane, cross the globe or enter into a completely new social context in order to share the Gospel....BUT in other times, we are called to begin sharing it *right where we are*. In our:

- Families
- Amongst our friends
- With our co-workers, business partners, customers and contacts
- In the ocean, on the beach trails, the golf course, the slopes and beyond
- ***Where are your missional spaces? 1 Corinthians 7:20 says "Yes, each of you should remain as you were when God called you."***

Verse 20 "So the man started off to visit the Ten Towns of that region and began to proclaim the great things Jesus had done for him; and everyone was amazed at what he told them."

The greatest _____ so often begins with _____.

Paul was made NEW, the Demoniac was set FREE...enter in a famous Biblical character....Moses. When faced with a life altering call from God, Moses responded with excuses & questions:

"But Moses protested to God, "Who am I to appear before Pharaoh? Who am I to lead the people of Israel out of Egypt?" - Exodus 3:11

Moses could only see his *own* limitations, his *own* failures and how *own* inabilities. However, God didn't *remove* his speech problem...God used him *in spite of it!* Rather than removing his inabilities....God promised to BE WITH MOSES!
