HOW THE RESCUED LIVE

*Do not have **other gods** besides me.*

*Do not **make an idol for yourself**, whether in the shape of anything in the heavens above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth. Do not bow in worship to them, and do not serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, bringing the consequences of the fathers' iniquity on the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate me, but showing faithful love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commands.*

*Do not **misuse the name of the Lord your God**, because the Lord will not leave anyone unpunished who misuses his name.*

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: You are to labor six days and do all your work, but the seventh day is a **Sabbath to the Lord your God**. You must not do any work—you, your son or daughter, your male or female servant, your livestock, or the resident alien who is within your city gates. For the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and everything in them in six days; then he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and declared it holy. **Exodus 20:3-8**

Honour your father and your mother so that you may have a long life in the land that the Lord your God is giving you

Do not **murder**.

Do not **commit adultery**.

Do not **steal**.

Do not **give false testimony** against your neighbour.

Do not **covet** your neighbour's house. Do not covet your neighbour's wife, his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbour. **Exodus 20:12-17**

DO WHATEVER IT TAKES TO REMEMBER!

God spoke to Moses: "Speak to the People of Israel. Tell them that from now on they are to make tassels on the corners of their garments and to mark each corner tassel with a blue thread. **When you look at these tassels you'll remember and keep all the commandments of God**, and not get distracted by everything you feel or see that seduces you into infidelities. The tassels will signal remembrance and observance of all my commandments, to live a holy life to God. **I am your God who rescued you from the land of Egypt to be your personal God. Yes, I am God, your God.**" Numbers 15:38-41
